







Cottonwood Creek outlet at Moonlight Beach to seawall at Cardiff Reef.

Permitted/Prohibited Uses:

1.Recreational take by hook-and-line from shore is allowed. 2.The recreational take of pelagic finfish, including Pacific bonito, and white seabass by spearfishing is allowed. 3. Take pursuant to beach nourishment and other sediment management activities and operation and maintenance of artificial structures inside the conservation area is allowed per any required federal, state and local permits, or as otherwise authorized by the department.
